In cooperation with **Marion County Chamber of Commerce's Civil War Living History Day**, the **Historic Jefferson Railway** is pleased to invite your school or group to attend The Great Locomotive Chase-The Andrews Raid.

Bring your class to ride an antique live steam train and experience the story of The Andrews Raid, the Civil War's most gripping railroad story, known as the "Great Locomotive Chase". See the living history camps along the river.

We are offering special pricing to school and other groups of \$5 per person on Friday, May 4, 2018. The train will depart at 10:30, 11:30 and 12:30. Additional trains may be added depending on demand. Trains always leave on time so please plan your arrival to allow plenty of time to park and walk to the train.

The route skirts the Big Cypress Bayou for a five-mile, half hour round trip that departs from the Diamond Don RV Park, just one mile from Jefferson. Along the way, passengers view one of the few remaining Confederate powder magazines from the Civil War era and other historic sites. Also, come see the Diamond Don Gator Pit with fourteen live alligators in a natural habitat. Be sure to reserve a place for your group!

We offer lunch facilities with clean port-a-potties. Bring your own lunches as we have space for a meal. Snacks, water, soda will be available for sale at the RV Park.

What: The Great Locomotive Chase - The Andrews Raid

When: Friday, May 4, 2018

Time: Train departs at 10:30, 11:30 and 12:30. Additional trains may be added depending on demand.

Where: 1602 State Hwy 49 East, Jefferson, Texas 75657

Directions: From Hwy 59, take Hwy 49 East toward Downtown Jefferson. Left at Y in Road to 49 East toward Smithland. RV park is one mile on the right.

Cost: \$5.00 for each student and parent. Schools: One Teacher and Bus Driver FREE.

Tour: 30 minutes

What to Wear: Walking shoes and jeans. Depending on weather, a jacket may also be appropriate. You will be in open air coaches.

What to Bring: Mosquito spray, suntan lotion, sun glasses, hat, lunch, drinks, money for vendors and concessions. Minor release forms.

Lunch facilities with clean port-a-potties: Bring your own sack lunches. We have plenty of space. Snacks, Sodas and Water will be available for sale at the RV Park.

- Our gate personnel will direct you to the parking area. Traffic is limited to existing roads. Please drive safely and slowly as we have many school children and spectators on the property. The steam train ride always leaves on time so please schedule your arrival to allow plenty of time to park and walk to the train.
- Parents/teachers/chaperones will be held liable for children's conduct. Please be considerate of other groups on the property throughout the day.
- Parents/Teachers/Chaperones for the trip must keep their assigned group of students with them at all times. Failure to supervise students appropriately may result in the group being asked to leave the premises.
- Please stay aware of your surroundings, as demonstrations may be unsafe for those not paying attention to their personal safety.
- Please leave as little sign of your being here as possible. Trashcans are available throughout the park. Please pick up after yourself and the children.
- Do not go near our railroad track. Any person caught tampering or vandalizing the track will be immediately *ejected from the property*. Tampering with our track creates a dangerous situation as it could cause our train to de-rail!!
- Please do not block any designated roadways or RV spaces.

Age specific narration aboard the train. Each trip is tailored to suit your specific age group; narration can be focused on a particular subject (steamboats, trains, Jefferson history, eco-habitat, alligators, the Civil War, etc.)

Flexible scheduling options. Start a day in Jefferson with a morning train ride or have a pleasant afternoon trip. Time of departure is up to you.

Tiered pricing - the larger the group, the lower the price. (per train ride for gas-powered locomotive. Call for pricing for steam train)

- Less than 70 students = \$6 per ticket (\$350 minimum, per train)
- 70-100 students = \$5 per ticket
- Above 100 = \$4 per ticket

There is a 50% security deposit required at time of booking. No cancellations within seven days of event. (Special events require 21 day cancellation).

For children under 8, we require one adult for each 15 students. For children 8 and older, we require one adult for each 20 students. Parent Release Forms are required for each student.

Payment in full is required for all groups before entry into the property. A credit card is required to guarantee attendance. If group does not show for the event, the balance of the ticket price will be charged to the credit card on deposit.

- What:** Civil War Living History – demonstrations of the era; actual ruins from 1800's are viewable on the property; Diamond Don Gator Pit – fourteen live alligators in a natural habitat; cannons, replica of working Civil War Iron Clad gunboat complete with five working cannons; crafts and games; steam train rides
- When:** Friday, May 4, 2018
- Time:** Day of Learning will be 9:00 – 2:30. Each school/group attending will have a confirmed reservation as to what time to be at the Camps.
- Where:** Diamond Don RV Park, 1602 State Hwy 49 East, Jefferson, Texas 75657. See www.DiamondDonRVPark.com for a map to the park.
- Directions:** From Hwy 59, take Hwy 49 East toward Downtown Jefferson. Go past Brookshires and turn Left at Y in Road, Hwy 49 East toward Smithland. Park is one mile on the right.
- Cost:** \$3.00 per student, parent. Schools: One Class Room Teacher and One Bus Driver admitted *FREE*. Home schools require payment for each parent, student.
- Train Ride:** Add a narrated antique live steam train ride on the Historic Jefferson Railway to your field trip. Add \$5.00 per person. See information on the Great Locomotive Chase. The steam train ride always leaves on time so please schedule your arrival to allow plenty of time to park and walk to the train.
- What to Wear:** Walking shoes and jeans. No flip/flop sandals. Depending on weather, a jacket may also be appropriate. You will be in a pasture and walking on gravel roads.
- What to Bring:** Mosquito spray, suntan lotion, sun glasses, hat, lunch, drinks, and money for concessions and vendors.
- Concessions:** Snacks, Sodas and Water will be available for purchase.
- Vendors:** Civil War vendors will be on site with age-appropriate items for sale.
